Invest \$31 million in capital projects through 2026.

Including investing \$16 million in key role as an industrial land bank and industrial building bank to grow Licking County's economy.

The Port Authority completed 87% of projects anticipated in it's 2007 capital plan.

Add 125,000 s.f. in new industrial building construction.

Acquire 125,000 s.f. of industrial building space.

Acquire 300 acres of rail-served industrial land for future development.

The Port Authority will own 1.2 million s.f. and have developed 650 acres by 2026.

Investing \$10 million in updates to existing facilities to retain jobs.

Replace 400,000 square feet of roof.

Pave 9,000 linear feet of road and 630,000 square feet of parking space.

The Port Authority will continue to re-invest in the future of the Aerospace Center.

Major Projects by the Port Authority anticipated by 2026 include:

-) Invest to gain and maintain Center of Excellence status for the Boeing Building.
-) Modernize labs at the Air Force Primary Standards Lab.
-) Build four more 20,000 s.f. industrial spec buildings in Licking County.
-) Construct a major, new office/laboratory building on the original Base property.
- Acquire and prepare for development Licking County's next generation industrial park.
