© **A success story.** The Heath-Newark-Licking County Port Authority took ownership of the former Newark AFB in October 1996, becoming the first privatization-in-place in military history. The facility was renamed the Central Ohio Aerospace & Technology Center and celebrated 50 years in 2012.



© **Called one of Ohio's finest examples of a public-private partnership,** the Aerospace Center brags the presence of *Fortune 500* companies to small businesses. Today, the Center's 15 employers include Boeing, Bionetics, AFMETCAL, UTC Aerospace Systems, and others doing what the Air Force once did, and more.

© **Impactful.** Combined, the public and private partners at the Center employ 775 with a payroll over \$60 million. The annual economic impact is estimated at more than \$200 million.

© **In the Top 5.** The Aerospace Center is among the Top 5 largest concentrations of the aerospace and defense industry in Ohio.

© **The face of Boeing in Ohio.** Boeing, as a company, did a total of \$8.2 billion in business in Ohio in 2011. That's fully 1.7% of Ohio's Gross State Product. Boeing's largest presence in the state is at the Aerospace Center in Heath.

© **UTC expansion.** UTC Aerospace Systems expanded its engineering operations in 2011. A \$5.7 million new office and clean room building opened June 2011 with capacity for future growth.
