The 350-acre Central Ohio Aerospace and Technology Center (COATC) campus is a combination of the original 56 acres acquired from the Air Force as part of the privatization of the former Newark Air Force Base in 1996, The Base Campus, as well as 290 acres acquired in 2002 as part of a planned expansion, the South Campus. The property is managed and developed by the Heath-Newark-Licking County Port Authority.

On November 2nd, ground was broken for a roadway project expected to be completed Summer 2005.

This represents the first major improvements to this property in over 50 years!
