**News Headlines from Tuesday, March 27th 2007****TEEN FACES FELONY CHARGE FOR BOMB THREAT**

A 13 year old student at Liberty Union Middle School in Lancaster is in hot water today for allegedly e-mailing a bomb threat to the school principal. Fairfield County Sheriff Dave Phalen says the threat was sent prior to school on March 13th and no bomb was found. Litzinger e-mailed the threat through a re-mailer service in England. Phalen says the boy now faces a felony charge of inducing panic. He's currently in custody of his mother.

SCHRIDER INDICTED

A Utica man wanted by Licking County authorities has been indicted in Florida on murder charges. Trevor Schrider facing a host of charges in connection with the death of a Florida man earlier this month. The twenty-nine-year old Schrider is wanted in Licking County for the attempted murder of Timothy Logue. On Jan. 17 authorities say Schrider allegedly set Logue on fire following an argument over money. He was initially arrested on an unrelated drug charge the day of the incident, but he posted fifty dollars bond and disappeared.

CONTRACT APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

Newark city council's Personnel Committee approving a new three year contract between the city and the firefighters union. The deal provides salary increases of one percent this year, three percent next year and 2.5 percent in 2009. The contract now goes before full council for approval.

SOLDIER DIES FROM FALL

A soldier from Pataskala died over the weekend from injuries he suffered from a fall from a balcony. Tech specialist Christopher Martin Ferguson was on active duty at Fort Hood, in Texas when he was fatally injured March 18th in Killeen. Local authorities say alcohol played a role in the accident. Ferguson was just twenty-one years old.
