The Port Authority joined an elite group Thursday. Official word of approval of a \$3.4 million grant under Ohio's brand new Ohio Job Ready Sites grant program came from Governor Taft. The grant was the result of a multi-partner effort in Pataskala aimed at creating a 305-acre rail-served site with access to U.S. Route 40.
