\$21 Million Capital Plan Accepted

Under the theme "Listening," the Port Authority wrapped up the 2007 Update to its 10-year capital improvements plan. The plan now predicts \$21 million in projects through 2016. The projects range from maintenance (the last major roof project is on the horizon) to expansion (a future land bank property purchase is set). The plan was accepted at the June Port Authority Board meeting.
