The Port Authority is out to bids with the first phase of a walking path on the south side of The Base. It's hoped that this path will not only fulfill a promise for a delineated path made to Base personnel but also, some day, connect to Licking County's extensive network. Expectations of that happening went up last week with word that Heath was to get a \$400,000 state grant to build the next stage of its network and reach The Base. Commuting to work via foot and pedal power may get easier.
