2008 Capital Projects Total \$6 Million

The Port Authority budget for 2008 includes funding for up to \$6 million in capital improvement projects. The projects include bridge, roadway, entrance, and parking improvements that will impact the east side of The Base as well as modest improvements visible on the west side as well.
