COATC Moves to Tobacco-Free Campus

Today, the Port Authority published a new tobacco-free campus policy that takes affect May 31, 2008. The implementation of the policy begins this month with the removal of two glass smoker huts found by the Licking County Health Dept. to be out of compliance with the voter-passed, statewide smoking ban.
