On Target News has day-by-day updates following the storm spawned by Hurricane Ike. The storm brought catastrophic room damage to Building 4 at The Base along with a host of other damage totaling an estimated \$250,000. The high bay roof is now "water tight" again and, with rain now in the forecast, the entire roof, which saw 93 different repair sites, will get its first post-storm test soon.
