The Port Authority announced the recent signing of a lease extension by Bionetics' for lease of the office building for the AFMETCAL program. The extension carries the lease for the 29,000 s.f. building through September 2015. This is the third major new lease signed by the Port Authority in the past 12 months involving over 820,000 s.f. of space at the Aerospace Center.
