Advocate reported today that Southgate Corporation of Newark, a decades-long leader in building speculative buildings for industry in suburban markets, signed a contract to buy a 6.9 acre site from the Port Authority earlier this



month. The tenant remains prospective, that's why it's a spec building, but the focus is on manufacturing to occupy the space. The building will stand west of the intersection of James Parkway and Kaiser Drive in Heath.
