Approval of a State of Ohio tax credit came about Monday and caused word to get out that a German Company, Xperion, has decided to locate on the Aerospace Center campus in Heath. In 2014, the automotive supplier will occupy the Southgate-built building under construction at James Parkway and Kaiser Drive. The manufacturer predicts it will employ 59 people within a few years.
