Industrial Spec Building Takes Shape

Three sides of the Southgate Corporation's latest industrial spec building are up with steel set to arrive soon. The 50,000 sq. ft. building is being built on speculation by Southgate on Kaiser Drive. The project marks the fourth spec building in three years in the manufacturing corridor along St. Rt. 79. Combined with the xperion and MISTRAS Group projects, the building forms a trio of projects that makes Kaiser Drive and James Parkway the "hot corner" in Heath.
