Seeing Weather More Ways Than One

For more than a dozen years now, the Port Authority has operated an on-site weather station with more ways of seeing the weather than just one. The weather station has a remote pavement sensor than reports the temperature of a section of asphalt. It's useful to know what those temperatures are to know when conditions support thaw or not. Today's pavement hit 15 degrees F. That's pretty cold.
