\$31 Million Capitol Plan Unveiled

By the year 2026, \$31 million in investment will bring the Port Authority to ownership of 1.2 million sq. ft. of industrial building space and having developed 650 acres of industrial land. The predictions come from the 2016 Update to the Port Authority's 10-Year Capital Plan. Hard to predict? Yes, but the 2007 version of the 10-year plan saw 87% of projects completed to plan.
