The new Western Entrance to the Boeing Building is more than an aesthetic, safety, and security improvement for the workforce. It's a project that shows off the Licking County business capabilities.

JBA Architects of Newark designed the new entrance. C.S. Construction of Newark built it.

The brick came from Bowerston Shale in Hanover Township installed by the masons from Corner Stone of Utica. Salyer Electric of Newton Township installed the lights. The sign came from Kessler Signs in Zanesville. The steel framing came from Precision Welding in Cambridge. That's just part of the list of local, skilled providers.
