## Manufacturer Chooses 20-Acre Site

On Monday, a food packaging manufacturer, Ohio Pack, announced plans to build a 135,000 sq. ft. facility on a 20-acre site at the Port Authority's Aerospace Center campus. The availability of a ready-to-go rail-served site, access to Licking County's manufacturing



workforce, and legacy of clean room-based manufacturing were key factors in the company's location decision. The \$25 million project expects to open in 2018.
