Lab Modernization Project Complete

Recently, the Port Authority turned over the keys for a new \$6.8 million modernized Force Lab addition to the Air Force Primary Standards Laboratory. The building was completed in August with equipment installation expected in 2020.

The AFPSL is the largest of the Pentagon's standards laboratories and has a 57-year history in Licking County with 52 different metrology labs. The Force Lab is the second of the labs to get a major update as part of a modernization effort.

A modern, industrial building of 20,000 sq. ft. is being added to the Port Authority's available building space portfolio with the start of a new building being built on speculation. The building will be move-in ready with two docks, one drive-in door, and 1,100 s.f. of office space. The building at 660 International Drive is slated to be available 2Q 2020. It's designed to target the manufacturing industry sector in Central Ohio's largest manufacturing corridor.
